

## **ANDRÉ FRANCO MONTORO FILHO**

Graduated in Economics from FEA/USP (University of São Paulo), spent his entire university career at the University of São Paulo, where he was first hired in 1966. He received his doctorate (Ph.D.) outside of Brazil—at Yale University in the United States—and then passed required public exams to earn a full professor's chair in 1983. He was Assistant Director of Faculty in Economics at USP and President of FIPE (*Fundação Instituto de Pesquisas Econômicas*—Foundation for Economic Studies). At the same time he also held many important public offices: President of BNDES (*Banco Nacional de Desenvolvimento Econômico e Social*—National Bank for Economic and Social Development), President of the Committee for the Federal Program of Privatization, and the State Secretary of Economic Planning for the State of São Paulo.
